

## Road landing for a fixed wing aircraft

Inform pilot of any obstacles likely to obstruct the approach and take off areas, wind direction and speed estimate.

- > Preferred sealed road surface free of undulations, ruts or pot holes.
- > 2 kilometres (2,000 metres) of straight road.
- > Road must be at least 15 metres (50 ft) wide.
- > All guide posts, road signs or obstacles above ground level must be removed for the full 2,000 metres.
- > Both ends of the 2,000 metres must be guarded by a responsible person, to stop any vehicles entering.
- > Establish UHF CH 5 communication between support vehicles and RFDS aircraft.
